**2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

- (i) All the championships mentioned below should have been conducted under the aegis of recognized International / National / State Sports Federations and also recognized by the Railway Sports Promotion Board.
- (ii) For recruitment of sports persons, on the basis of sports achievements in Junior National Championships, the age groups as mentioned against each discipline shall only be considered.



## 2.1 Sports Achievements:


**Applicant should be currently an active player and should have fulfilled the sports achievements on or after "01.04.2017" and before the date of Notification.**

Certificates in support of the sports achievements must be uploaded along with the application form.

The minimum sports norms for recruitment of sportspersons in different Grade Pay (6<sup>th</sup> CPC) or equivalent Levels (7<sup>th</sup> CPC) for both team and individual events are given as under.

These provisions shall be read along with Notes given in Para 2.3 and Para 2.4 below.

2.4. **Educational Qualification:** Candidates should possess requisite minimum education qualification on the date of Notification. Those who are appearing at and/or awaiting results of final examination are not eligible:

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**\*NOTE:** If the suitable candidate is recommended for Jr.Steno (level-4) post, the said candidate has to qualify the skill test prior to appointment, with 80 words per minute in Shorthand (Hindi/English) for a duration of 10 minutes which will be transcribed in typing in 50 minutes for English and in 65 minutes for Hindi.

**2.5. Age: Minimum 18 years and Maximum 25 years of age as on 01.01.2020**  
i.e. must have been born not earlier than **02.01.1995** and not later than **01.01.2002**.

(Note: Matriculation or its equivalent certificate from recognized Board should be submitted for proof of date of birth). **No age relaxation is allowed (even for SC/ST/OBC candidates).**

### **3. SELECTION PROCEDURE:**

#### **3.1 Stages of recruitment:-**

The recruitment will be based on following two stages:-

- a) Sports Trial.
- b) Assessment of Sports Achievements and Educational Qualification.

#### **3.1.1 Sports Trials:-**

The candidates, who will be FIT in Trials by the Trial Committee, only will be recommended for next stage.

**NOTE:** The date, time and venue of Sports Trial will be fixed by the RRC and will be intimated to the eligible candidates in due course. No request for postponement of the Sports Trial will be entertained under any circumstances.

### 3.1.2 Assessment of Sports Achievements and Educational Qualification:-

Recommended candidates will be assessed by duly constituted Recruitment Committee for their sports achievements and educational qualification.

**NOTE :** Candidates having higher educational qualification shall be given higher marks as decided by duly constituted Recruitment Committee.

### 3.2 Qualifying Marks:-

Final merit list will be prepared on the basis of total marks awarded by Trial Committee and Recruitment Committee. Minimum qualifying marks are as under:

#### **NOTE:**

- (i) The Recruitment process is based purely on the merit of the candidates as per vacancies, in a particular discipline, notified. **Canvassing in any form will attract disqualification.**
- (ii) In case more than one sports person scores the same mark, preference would be given to the younger candidate.





#### 4. HOW TO APPLY:

##### 4.1. **Application Fee.**

Candidates should submit application fee for an amount mentioned below:

\*Minorities includes Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists, Zoroastrians (Parsis) and Jain.

**NOTE:** Certificate in proof of the above issued by the authorities authorized to issue such certificate should be enclosed along with the application form for getting relaxation in the application fee. Candidates should check their eligibility thoroughly before applying. **Fee in respect of candidates who are ineligible, shall not be refunded.**

##### 4.2. **Procedures for payment of examination fees:-**

- Payment will have to be made online through payment gateway as part of online application process.
- The payment can be made by using debit card / credit card / Internet Banking / e-wallets, etc. by providing information as asked on the system.
- For online payment/refund, transaction charges, if any, will be borne by the candidate.
- If the online transaction is not successfully completed, please login again and make payment for the same.

- iii) For claiming relaxation in application fees: Caste certificate for SC/ST; Minority certificate (Annexure-E); PwBD certificate; ESM (front page of service book), Economic Backward Classes.  
NOTE: Candidates belonging to economically backward classes mean the candidates whose family income is less than 50,000/- per annum. Annexure-D duly filled and signed by the competent authority shall be uploaded.
- iv) Duly filled Annexure-A along with supporting certificates
- v) OBC certificate as per Annexure-'B' and OBC declaration as per Annexure-'C'.

**4.4. Procedure to be followed for applying online:**

4.4.1 Candidates are required to apply ONLINE by visiting [www.rrcbbs.org.in](http://www.rrcbbs.org.in)  
Detailed instructions for filling up ONLINE applications will be available on the website.

4.4.2 Candidates are required to click on the link provided for filling ONLINE applications and fill up the personal details/BIO- DATA etc carefully.

**NOTE-I:** Candidates should ensure that their name, father's name, date of birth is exactly as recorded in Matriculation or equivalent certificate. Any deviation found during Document Verification will lead to cancellation of candidature and also debarment.

**NOTE-II:** Candidates are advised to indicate their active mobile number and valid e-mail ID in the ONLINE application and keep them active during the entire engagement process as all important messages will be sent by email/SMS which will be treated as deemed to have been read by the candidates.

**5. INVALID APPLICATIONS:**

The applications having any of the following deficiencies/discrepancies or irregularities will be summarily rejected:

- i) Application without proper scanned photograph and signature.
- ii) Application without proper certificates, in respect of date of birth, educational/ sports achievements,
- iii) Caste (SC/ST) certificate and other certificates not obtained from the appropriate authority in the prescribed format.
- iv) Any other deemed irregularity.

6. **OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS :**

- (i) Eligible/Ineligible status of the candidate shall be made available on East Coast Railway website as well as in Railway Recruitment Cell (RRC)'s website. Such status will also be communicated through email and SMS.
- (ii) Eligible applicants can download call letters from RRC/BBS website (rrcbbs.org.in) for the sports trials.
- (iii) Candidates need not send any application print outs or certificates or copies to RRC/Bhubaneswar by post.
- (iv) Selected candidates have to pass the requisite medical fitness standards prior to appointment.
- (v) In the event of appointment as Clerk-cum- typist posts in Group-C railway service, candidates will be required to acquire typing proficiency of 30 w.p.m. in English or 25 w.p.m. in Hindi within a period of two years from the date of appointment, and till such time, appointment will be provisional.
- (vi) Selected candidates are likely to be posted anywhere on East Coast Railway after successful completion of all pre-appointment formalities, including training wherever prescribed.
- (vii) Decision of East Coast Railway in all matters relating to this recruitment shall be final.
- (viii) There will not be any provision for withdrawal of application once submitted.


7. **LEGAL JURISDICTION:** For any legal disputes, the jurisdiction will be the Central Administrative Tribunal, Cuttack.
